## Participants:

The National Mediation Board requires the following information from PSA Airlines, Inc. (Carrier) by <u>4:00 PM</u> on <u>October 24, 2024</u>:

- 1. Provide some brief background information about the Carrier.
- On October 15, 2024, in a document identified as Exhibit 3, the Transport Workers Union of America (TWU) submitted a Carrier job posting for the position of Ground Instructor. The posting states that Ground Instructors are "[r]esponsible for making . . . recommendation[s] for simulator training." Explain what that means.
- 3. Identify the job titles of Carrier employees who perform pilot training functions; submit position descriptions for each of those jobs; identify the number of Carrier

employees who perform each of those jobs as of September 20, 2024; and explain where those jobs are in the Carrier's organizational structure (or provide an organizational chart).

Additionally, by <u>4:00 PM</u> on <u>October 24, 2024</u>, the Carrier and TWU may submit any other information they deem relevant to this case.
